

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- Following Jesus is hard because we need to leave our old self and life behind and surrender ourselves to His will and purpose.
- But following Jesus is easy because we can do it by His power, not ours. We don't even have to worry about it. We know He is faithful and His promise is sure.
- Ultimately, following Jesus is just the first step in the journey of our lives. We are all being moulded to be like Christ. Until we get there, each time we sin, we can go back to God, repent, and be restored in our relationship with Him.
