Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- Discipleship is relationship. It involves both a spiritual and human connection.
- It's a lifetime journey of following Jesus and being accountable in community.
- We can never be fully discipled, because we are constantly growing.
- In discipleship, we grow to be like Jesus, grow in

community, and grow to impact our world.

- Jesus paid the ultimate price for us on the cross, but there's still a cost for us. Discipleship costs us everything, tests what we treasure, and shifts our values to be God's values.
- When we truly follow Jesus, we will grow spiritually mature, have strengthened relationships, and see our church and communities transformed.

- Thank God for those who guided you to follow Him! Pray for clear leading and growth in your relationship with God and others. Pray to do His will in all areas.

 God's transformation. Pray for God's grace to

put His will above yours, love like Jesus, and value what He values.
