### Engage

 Start the conversation with this question...

What do you feel is your “superpower” at school, home, or work—like a skill or ability that God gave you?

### Key Points

 Connect to God’s truth by sharing...

- We all have a different role to play in God’s kingdom. For this, the Holy Spirit gives and activates the spiritual gifts in our lives.
- It’s God who empowers us, so we need to remember not to be self-reliant or overconfident.
- The gifts God gives us are diverse! However, they only find their fulfillment when united with the body of Christ.
- God gives everyone unique gifts and strengths. Everyone’s role has a purpose.
- Ultimately, we must value the spiritual gifts and not waste them. We must use our gifts to serve others and exercise them in faith.

## **Discuss Together** *(pick at least one)*

- Do you know your spiritual gifts? What is one way you can serve others with your God-given spiritual gifts?
- Do you sometimes feel excluded or separated from your specific church community? Have you ever isolated yourself because you feel different or rejected?
- How easy is it for you to appreciate differences within Christ's body? Do you usually fellowship and serve with people similar to, or different from you?

 Declare this truth based on your identity in Christ

## **Key Truth**

God has given me spiritual gifts to serve and build up the body of Christ.

## **Pray Together** *(pick at least one)*

- Thank God for His generous spiritual gifts that He gives to each one of us.
- Pray for the grace to use your spiritual gifts in faith and obedience. Ask God for specific ways you can serve others and build up the Church.
- Pray for each other's prayer requests.
