Key Points

 Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- In the story of the demon-possessed boy, his father was completely out of his depth.
- Sometimes, that's how life feels for us: impossible to handle.
- First, be honest and vulnerable with Jesus. Believe that He can handle the impossible, and acknowledge your own helplessness, doubts, and fears.
- Whether it's your own struggles or those of a friend or family member, Jesus gave us the answer: "Bring it to Me."
- Jesus is the ultimate confidante and the answer to all questions and situations—especially the impossible ones.

Discuss Together *(pick at least one)*

- Tell about a time you felt that there was no way out, and how God came through.
- How easy or hard is it for you to be humbly vulnerable to Jesus? Can you easily admit your helplessness? Why do you think this is so?
- Are there times you still struggle to trust God? He is divinely trustworthy, loving, and knows you from the inside out. He knows how you feel and what you need.

PROCLAIM

 Declare this truth based on your identity in Christ

Key Truth

I can bring my struggles, pain, and impossible situations to God, who works miracles and brings healing and peace.

Pray Together *(pick at least one)*

- Thank God for His great love, that He desires to help us in every situation.
- Pray for humility to admit your weakness and unbelief, come to God, and bring Him your struggles.
- Pray for each other's prayer requests.
