Key Points

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- Sometimes we think we can please God by giving Him things like our time, money, or volunteer work. But that's not how God works.
- God is not after what you can give—He's looking for you! He wants you to know His heart, desire intimacy with Him, and walk with Him. He calls all of us to act justly, love

mercy, and walk humbly.

- Acting justly means understanding and living lacksquareby God's standard of right and wrong.
- Loving mercy means caring for the • oppressed and forgiving those who have done wrong.
- Walking humbly means seeing others as \bullet significant as ourselves and serving without expecting praise.
- God wants our whole hearts. It's not just about being socially responsible—it's about how we live every day.



FELLOWSHIP GROUP MATERIAL

Discuss Together (pick at least one)

- How do you think you can act justly, love mercy, or walk humbly in your daily life?
- Which of the three is the hardest for you to do?
- Do you believe you treat people the way God wants you to?
- Do you ever feel like social responsibility becomes a task to check off instead of a reflection of your relationship with God? How can you deepen your connection with Him?

PROCLAIM

Declare this truth based on your identity in Christ

Key Truth

Through Christ, I can be socially responsible and show God's love and justice to others.

Pray Together (pick at least one)

- Thank God that He wants to have a relationship with you, more than seeing your actions or sacrifices.
- Ask God to help you listen to His heart and walk closely with Him in daily life.
- Pray for a heart that seeks justice, loves mercy, and walks humbly before God and others.
- Pray for each other's prayer requests.
