Start the conversation with this question...

What's something you enjoy more when you experience it with others—like a concert, meal, or game? Why do you think that is?

Key Points



Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- While our personal moments with God are essential, we are also called to worship in community.
- What unites us in worship? God's peace, His message, and His name. We can worship God together because what unites us is greater than what divides us.
- How can worship be a lifestyle, not just a religious ceremony? We can follow the example of the early church: they shared life with each other, pursued God together, shared each other's burdens, gave generously, and met regularly.
- How can we worship together as believers? By meeting together, helping each other hold on to hope, and encouraging each other to love and follow God.

Discuss Together (*pick at least one*)

- How are your relationships in your church community? Are you close enough to other believers to see how God is working in their lives?
- Obeying God is not always convenient or comfortable—that's why we need each other! Who spurs you to do what's right and follow Jesus?
- God doesn't want a church community that's competitive or critical. What are some things that hurt or seem to break the unity in the church?

PROCLAIM



Declare this truth based on your identity in Christ

Key Truth

In Christ, I can worship God in community with fellow believers.

Pray Together (*pick at least one*)

- Ask God to deepen your relationships in your church community. Pray for unity and joy as you worship Him together.
- Pray against anything that might be shaking the unity in your church community.
- Pray for each other's prayer requests.
