 Start the conversation with this question...

Key Points

 Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- God designed His Church to gather together! Fellowship with other believers is an essential part of following Jesus.
- As the Body of Christ, we're called to bring God's kingdom to earth by living like Jesus—through how we speak, act, and treat others. This includes being united and encouraging one another.
- When we have fellowship with one another, we are gathering as God meant us to.
- He also gave us the responsibility to guide and correct one another.
- There's power when we pray together and agree in what we ask God for (Matthew 18:19).
- When we gather in His name, we know His presence is there (Matthew 18:20).

Discuss Together (*pick at least one*)

- Do you have a church community you can fellowship with easily?
- How has your community molded you as a follower of Christ?
- How have you seen God work when His people gather in His name?
- Are there areas where you need to grow in unity, encouragement, or correction within your spiritual community?
