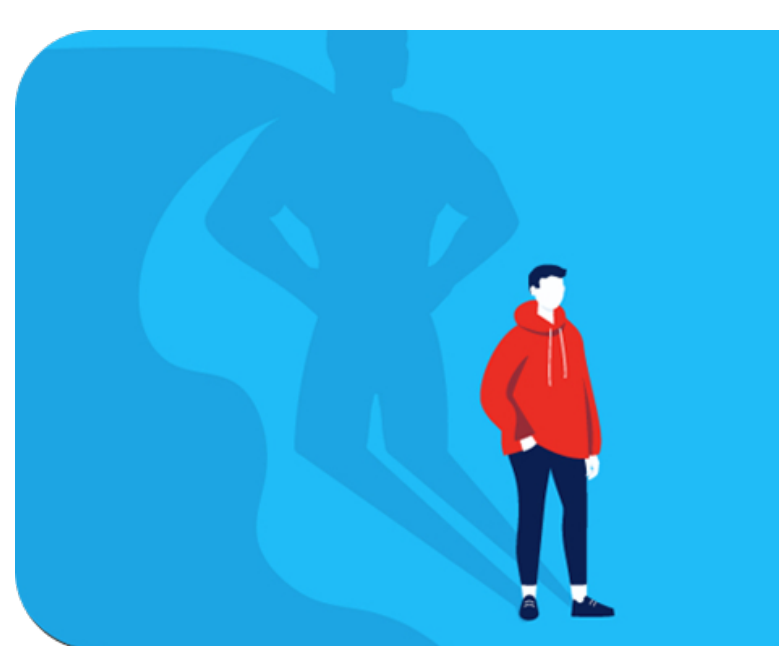

Key Points *(covered in the Meditate video)*



Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- The Church is God's family and His body on earth—a community of people who follow Jesus and help others follow Him.
- When Peter boldly proclaimed Jesus as Lord and Savior who died and rose again, people believed. God affirmed their belief by giving the Holy Spirit through Jesus. They were added to the Church and became part of the community of believers.

PAIASE

Read the key Scripture (**Acts 2:42–47**)
on the front page together.

- The early church gathered together and grew in faith by praying, meditating, proclaiming His Word, and being in fellowship together. As they did so, God added to the church daily those who were being saved.
- In Every Nation Church, we exist to honour God by establishing Christ-centred, Spirit-empowered, socially-empowered churches and campus ministries in every nation.

lack and suffer hunger; But those who
seek the LORD shall not lack any
good thing.”

Optional:

- Invite one or two volunteers to share what they received from the Lord.

Discuss Together *(pick at least one)*

- What questions do you have about what it means to be part of the church—not just attending, but really belonging?
