Key Points

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- Establishing someone in Jesus means helping them grow deeper in their faith—not just knowing about Jesus, but staying close to Him, being rooted in Him, and building a strong, lasting relationship with Him.
- Being established starts with this truth: Jesus is the foundation we are built on. Everything we are and everything we do begins with Him.
- How do we grow in Him?
 - Pray: Be established in prayer.
 - Meditate: Read and obey God's Word.
 - Proclaim: Declare God's truth.
 - Fellowship: Walk closely with others who follow Jesus.
- Ultimately, it's God who does the deep work
 of establishing people, and He invites us to be
 part of that journey with others.

Discuss Together (pick at least one)

- Which of the four (Pray, Meditate, Proclaim, Fellowship) do you want to grow in the most?
- How can you help someone else grow in any of these areas?
- How are you intentionally making Jesus the foundation of your life? What's one example of that? (e.g., at work, in your relationships, during hard times)



Key Truth

I am established in Christ, and I can help others be established in Him too.

- Pray to grow deeper in Jesus through prayer, meditating on His Word, proclaiming His truth, and the church community.
- Pray for you and those around you to be established firmly in God's truth, love, and hope.
