Engage

Start the conversation with this question...

What's one thing you believe is real even though you can't see it? How does that help you understand faith in God?

Key Points

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- What is faith, and why is it crucial for us?
- Faith looks beyond what we can see and anchors us to God.
- Faith is confidence in God's character. We can trust Him, especially when our feelings or thoughts say otherwise.
- Faith shows itself in obedience. Our faith and actions work together (James 2:22).
- Faith is for living the Christian life right now! Through faith, we can:
 - Approach God and have a real relationship with Him.
 - Experience God's peace even in the face of struggles.
 - Obey God even when we can't see what's next.
- Ultimately, faith rests on who God is—faithful, righteous, good, and loving.

Discuss Together *(pick at least one)*

- How would you explain “faith” in your own words?
- What makes it difficult for us to trust God sometimes?
- Can you share a time when your faith in God moved you to act—like obeying something He asked you to do?
- How can faith help us live with peace even when life feels uncertain?



PROCLAIM

Declare this truth based on your identity in Christ

Key Truth

In Christ, I can live with confident faith that trusts, obeys, and rests in God.

Pray Together *(pick at least one)*

- Thank God for the faith that saves you and the faith that helps you live each day. Thank Him for having a real relationship with you.
- Ask God for deeper faith in His promises. Pray for strength to obey Him, even when you can't see what's next.
- Pray for each other's prayer requests.
