Start the conversation with this question...

What's one situation where you had to trust someone completely? How did it feel?

Key Points

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- Through the gospels, we see many examples of faith in action. Here are just a few.
- Faith looks like gratitude. When Jesus healed ten lepers, only one came back to thank Him (Luke 17:11–17). Faith recognizes God as the source of every gift.
- Faith looks like persistence. The blind beggar kept crying out to Jesus until he was healed (Luke 18:35–43). Faith holds on to God despite delays, obstacles, or silence.
- Faith looks like humble trust. The widow gave her last two coins—all she had to live on—trusting God to provide (Luke 21:1–4). Faith surrenders everything, relying on God's grace and not our own strength.
- As followers of Jesus, we too can live out this kind of faith in our daily lives.

Discuss Together (pick at least one)

- What's one blessing in your life right now that you sometimes take for granted? How can you practice gratitude and faith for it this week?
- Have you ever prayed for something that didn't get answered quickly? What helped you keep trusting God while waiting?
- What's an area in your life that's hard for you to surrender or hand over to God?
 What step could you take to trust Him with it today?

Key Truth
