Key Points

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- **God is love.** Love is not just something God does—it's who He is. Everything He does flows from His perfect love. He shows what real love looks like—patient, kind, forgiving, and faithful.
- **We are called to love like Him.** Those who truly know God reflect His heart. Our love for others shows that we belong to Him.
(John 13:35)
- **God empowers us to love.** It's not easy to love everyone, but because we've received His love first, we can extend it to others by His Spirit.
- When we love others selflessly, truthfully, and humbly, the world sees a glimpse of God through us.

Discuss Together *(pick at least one)*

- How would you describe God's love?
- Why do you think loving others is sometimes hard?
- What's one way you can show love to someone in your family, office, school, or church this week?
- How can we remind each other to love like Jesus every day?
