Key Points

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- Advent means "arrival." We celebrate Jesus' first coming at Christmas, but we also remember that we're still waiting for His final return.
- Waiting isn't easy, especially in a fast-paced world.
 But we can wait with joy, strength, and courage because God has never failed His people, and He never will. His timing is perfect!
- Waiting is a part of life. Patience is a fruit of the Spirit, and God grows it in us as we follow Him each day.
- We wait with hope, not worry. Our hope is anchored in who God is, for He is faithful to fulfill every promise He has spoken.
- We wait actively, not passively. Waiting on God doesn't mean doing nothing. We keep praying, obeying, loving, serving, and staying faithful.

Discuss Together (pick at least one)

- What's something you find hard to wait for, and why?
- Psalm 27 says, "Take heart." What helps you stay hopeful when you're waiting on God for something?
- What is one way you can "wait actively" this week—something you can keep doing while trusting God's timing?
- Is there something you're waiting for right now that we can pray about together?



Key Truth

In Christ, I can wait with hope, strength, and faith because God is good and His timing is perfect.

Pray Together (pick at least one)

- Ask God to help you wait with a trusting heart.
- Thank Him for His goodness and faithfulness in every season.
- Pray for each other's prayer requests.
