When you're about to start something important, what helps you feel prepared?

Key Points

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- Before stepping into what God has promised, He calls us to prepare our hearts.
- **Consecration means being set apart for God.** We turn away from what's unclean, or anything that pulls us off course, and humble ourselves for God to work in us.
- **Consecration means seeking God first.** Before crossing into the Promised Land, God told His people to seek Him first. We consecrate ourselves by praying, meditating, proclaiming His truth, and being in fellowship with other believers who encourage us to follow Jesus.
- **Consecration prepares us to walk by faith.** When our focus is on God, we're able to obey Him and step forward—even when the path is unclear. Our faith grows as we keep our eyes on Jesus and trust Him to lead.
- When we consecrate ourselves to God, we move forward with expectant faith—empowered by the Spirit and strengthened to face what's ahead.

Discuss Together *(pick at least one)*

- What does it look like to “set yourself apart” for God in everyday life?
- How have prayer, God’s Word, or community helped you stay focused on Jesus?
- Are there any distractions you might need to let go of to help you connect more with God this year?
- What’s one step you’d like to take to seek God more intentionally this season?

Key Truth
