Engage

Start the conversation with this question...

Think of someone who stepped in to help you during a difficult situation. How did it feel knowing they were willing to go through it with you?

Key Points

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- Hebrews reminds us that Jesus didn't save us from a distance—He stepped into our world and our suffering.
- **Jesus entered our situation.** He became fully human, yet remained sinless. Even when obeying God led Him to suffering and death on the cross, He trusted God fully.
- **Jesus suffered so we could become God's family.** Through His death and resurrection, Jesus opened the way for us to be forgiven and welcomed into God's family as His children.
- **Jesus stands with us and for us.** He represents the Father's love to us and speaks to the Father on our behalf.
- Only through Jesus' perfection could we be made perfect. Because of Him, we are welcomed into God's family and given a new hope.

Discuss Together *(pick at least one)*

- How does knowing you are part of God's family change how you see yourself or your future?
- What's one situation where it's difficult for you to trust or obey God right now?
- How can remembering Jesus' sacrifice help you trust that He understands your struggles and can help you through them?



PROCLAIM

Declare this truth based on your identity in Christ

Key Truth

In Christ, I am part of God's family, holy and righteous.

Pray Together *(pick at least one)*

- Thank Jesus for coming as a human so we could be saved.
- Ask God to help you trust Him more deeply when life is difficult.
- Pray for hearts that desire God's will above everything else.
- Pray for each other's prayer requests.
