Start the conversation with this question...

What's something that frustrates you or that you find yourself complaining about?

Key Points

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- In the wilderness, God's people responded with wandering hearts. They complained, forgot what God had done, and doubted Him.
- But Jesus showed us a completely different way to live. He fully trusted the Father, even to the point of death on the cross.
- **Moses led Israel out of slavery, but Jesus brought a far greater salvation—rescuing us from sin and death.**
- **Israel experienced rest in the Promised Land for a generation. But through Jesus, we are invited into His greatest rest today and forever.**
- **So instead of hardening our hearts and forgetting God's faithfulness, let's fix our eyes on Jesus—following Him with soft, open, and responsive hearts.**
- As we do, we can experience His peace, trust and walk with Him daily, and look forward to eternity with Him.

Discuss Together (*pick at least one*)

- Share a time that God reminded you of His faithfulness, even when you forgot.
- Why do you think people can experience God's help but still struggle to fully trust Him afterward?
- What are some things that currently distract or pull your attention away from God?
- What is one step you would like to take for your heart to stay more open to God's voice this week?



PROCLAIM

Declare this truth based on your identity in Christ

Key Truth

In Christ, my heart stays soft and open to hearing, trusting, and obeying His voice.

Pray Together (*pick at least one*)

- Thank God for His faithfulness—even in the times we forget or doubt.
- Ask Him to keep our hearts soft and open to His voice each day.
- Pray to trust Jesus fully and walk closely with Him in every situation.
- Pray for each other's prayer requests.
