Engage

Start the conversation with this question...

Tell about a promise someone kept that meant a lot to you.

Key Points

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- Trust grows when someone proves they are faithful. Hebrews reminds us that while people may fail, God never does. What gives us confidence to keep trusting Him?
- **God is just.** He sees your faith, your love, and every way you serve His people. He will never forget what is done in His name.
- **God keeps His promises.** Just as He was faithful to Abraham, God always keeps His word. His promises are secure because His character never changes.
- **God gives us a sure hope.** Our hope is anchored in Jesus, our eternal High Priest, who has gone before us and made a way for us to draw near to God.
- Because God is faithful, we can patiently endure and hold firmly to the hope we have in Christ. Jesus is the sure and steady anchor for our souls.

Discuss Together *(pick at least one)*

- Share about a promise God has fulfilled in your life. How did that experience strengthen your trust in Him?
- Is there an area of your life where you're waiting on God right now? How does His faithfulness encourage you to keep trusting Him?
- Hebrews says God remembers the love we show as we serve others. How has serving others strengthened your own faith?
- What storm or challenge are you facing right now that makes it hard to stay anchored in Jesus? How can we pray for you?



PROCLAIM

Declare this truth based on your identity in Christ

Key Truth

In Christ, my hope is anchored in God's unchanging promises.

Pray Together *(pick at least one)*

- Thank God that His promises never change.
- Ask Him to help us trust Him patiently while we wait.
- Pray that our hope would remain firmly anchored in Jesus.
- Pray for each other's prayer requests.

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¹⁹We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain, ²⁰where our forerunner, Jesus, has entered on our behalf. He has become a high priest forever, in the order of Melchizedek.
